Josh Hanlon, Piano, currently tours with country music legend, Ray Price. Recognized for his distinctive style and an intriguing spark as an improviser and writer, Josh has made a mark as a performer, composer and educator. Josh holds a Masters Degree in Jazz Studies from the University of North Texas where he performed in the famed One O'Clock Lab Band. Josh has served on the faculty at UNT, Brookhaven College, and at St. Francis Xavier University in his native Canada.

Ken Edwards, Trumpet, was the featured soloist while on tour with the legendary trumpeter, Maynard Ferguson. Originally playing tuba and trombone, Ken made the switch to trumpet in college. Ken is an active performer and adjunct faculty member at the University of Texas in Arlington where he teaches jazz improvisation and jazz trumpet.
