

# Trombone Supply List

**NOTE: Students will START on a smaller, single trombone until January, and then will be required to trade in this instrument for a larger “Trigger” trombone for the rest of the year. There is only a \$10-\$13 difference per month in the bigger, permanent trombone, but the students will not be ready for the larger instrument until January.**
